

Hadsten

Today Hadsten has more than 8,000 inhabitants and is the largest of the municipality towns. The municipality of Favrskov belongs to the region Midtjylland.

Hadsten train station is placed in downtown Hadsten and is a 10 minutes walk from the school. In downtown you have supermarkets, hair dressers, banks, a pharmacy hardware- and convenience stores. Across the street from the train station you find Modelbane Europa, which is among the largest model railway exhibitions in Scandinavia. Several businesses and companies. Expedit, K.R. Hospitalsudstyr A/S and Svend Hoyer A/S are some of the businesses situated in the business district of Hadsten.

Hadsten is the „city of schools“. Besides from Technical College of Jutland (TCJ) which was established in 1928, the city of Hadsten contains a Folk High School, a gymnasium and a residential school.

Young city with roots into the past

The city of Hadsten is placed between two larger cities Randers and Aarhus, and emerged along the stretch of railway in east Jutland, which was inaugurated in 1862. The railway is passing through

a beautiful river valley along with the river. Around the river in the city of Hadsten a small park has been made. In the park which is called „Lilleåparken“ there are paths and benches and is used for recreation, jogging and walking. The river „Lilleåen“ is known for the best fishing waters in Denmark. If you walk through the valley and cross the road „Vestre Ringvej“ you meet the forest „Sølund“ which also contains paths for recreation, jogging, walking and biking. It is about 2 km to the forest from TCJ.

The street and road names of Hadsten testify that enterprising men through the ages have spent time in the city of Hadsten. One of the most famous was Frederik Ludvig Christian Bergmann Larsen, better known as Doctor Larsen – also mentioned as the miracle doctor. He lived in Hadsten. In 1864 he served the army and achieved great human knowledge, experiences that he used in his medical practice. Doctor Larsen was well known and patients came from all over Jutland. Also the great folklore collector Evald Tang Kristensen and freedom fighter Frits-Johan Blichfeldt Møller are among the famous men in Hadsten.

On the top of the hill in the southern part of the city is an old medieval church from the 13th century. As the city grew bigger a bigger and more central church was needed and the church of Sct. Poul was built in 1919 on construction land donated by the miracle doctor, doctor Larsen. The church built in neoclassical style is designed by the architect Hans Jørgen Kampmann who was inspired by some of the big churches in Copenhagen.

The city name Hadsten is known from 1432 as Halstiern, which can be interpreted both as an inland sea or steep hills and refers to the very marked landscape along the river valley. Archaeological excavations show that humans have lived in the valley 2000 years b. Kr.

Technical College of Jutland

Technical College of Jutland (TCJ) is a boarding school for vocational education and training (secondary level). Our college concentrate on a few main educational branches, but covers these branches vertically from beginner level through further and higher technical education (diploma) to the advanced postgraduate course level. Our educational branches are plastic processing, cooling systems and refrigeration, electricity and carpentry.

TCJ was founded in 1928 by an association of employers as an independent boarding school for vocational education and training. At that time TCJ mainly educated rural craftsmen and our primary educational branch was carpentry. Through our school's history of nearly 90 years, the college has gone through a tremendous evolution, which means, that we today can offer all our students/apprentices a very exciting and challenging education and training facility situated in a remarkable and inspiring school environment.

Our students/apprentices come from all over Denmark and the majority are staying at our college in our student homes during school periods. The college is following the US-campus philosophy and has a 24-hours

“open door” policy. Workshops and all other facilities can be used by students whenever they want. After normal class hours the students have the possibility to use the “learning center” at TCJ, which is manned with tutors (elderly students) and mentors (teachers) every night. Here students can find time to immerse themselves in projects, get help for school work if needed or be challenged by those who have the energy and find appropriate sparring partners to go further.

TCJ also provides training for graduated and trained craftsmen in the field of entrepreneurship, sustainable energy and in all the education areas of the school and have done so for more than 25 years. Business partners very often hold courses, training sessions or meetings at TCJ and many students at TCJ are offered internships abroad and through our large company network and relations.

TCJ's kitchen serve students and other course participants in the restaurant and bistro area. Every afternoon and evening the café (in the basement of the building “Vidar”) are open. In the café you can buy drinks and snacks and works as a social meeting point.

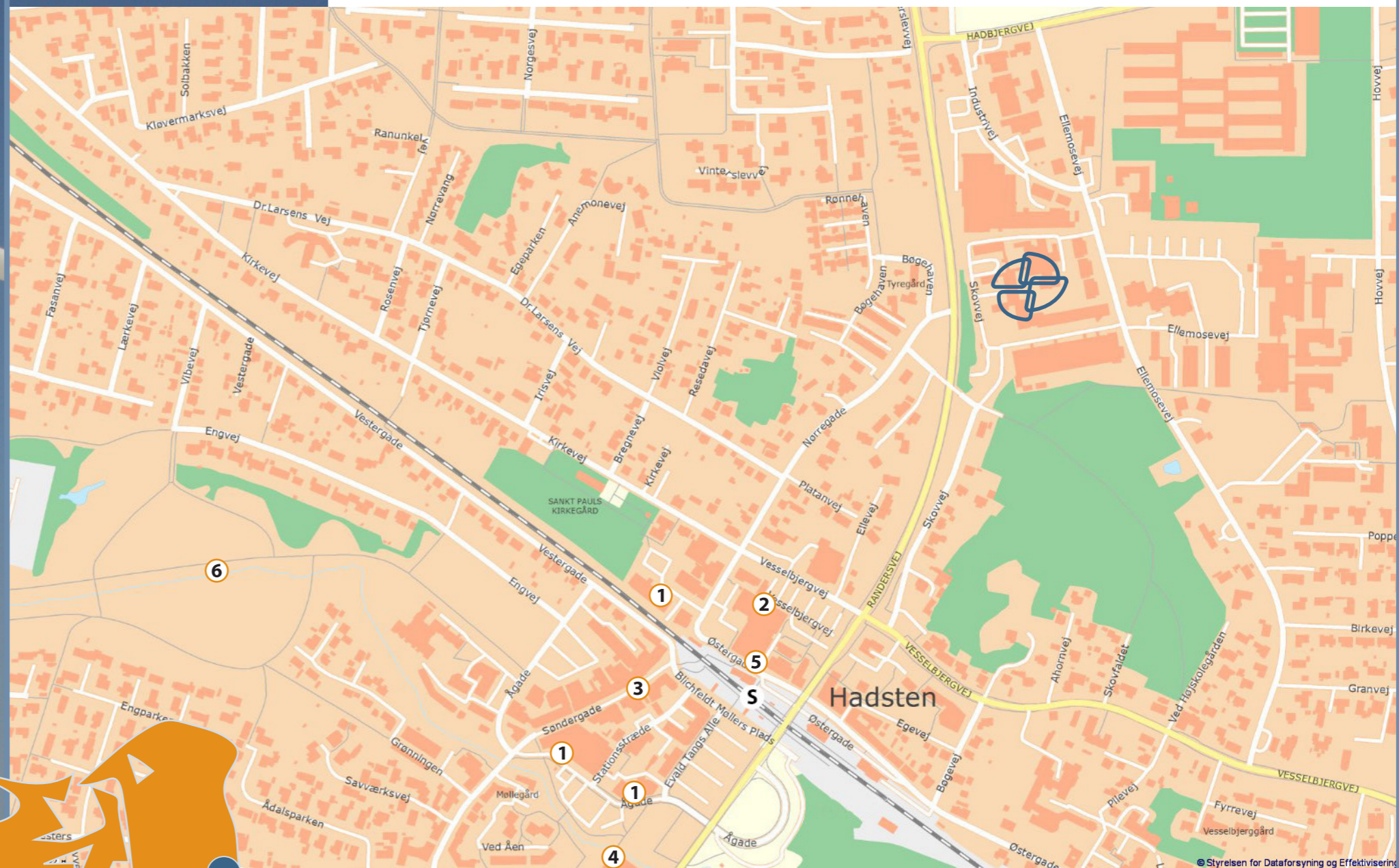
